## Service Offered

- Brief assessments and intervention
- Comprehensive assessments for those in prison and in the community
- Individual Case Management and intervention
- Driving Change programme, which is specifically aimed at reducing repeat impaired driving and is for clients with 3 or more Convictions
- Advice and information for family and whanau of those with substance misuse issues
- Triage and liaison with Community Probation and other Statutory agencies



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## Information on the service

### *For assessments and on-going treatment:*

If you are in the community, you can self-refer to ADAS, see your GP and request a referral, contact AOD Central Coordination Service or ask a professional involved in your care.

If you are in prison, please speak to your R&E Case Manager or your Unit PCO who can advise you. If you are on remand, assessments are requested by the Court or Community Probation
